If you vote for more candidates than you are entitled to, none of your votes will be counted.

In the Parish Council election you may vote for fewer candidates than you are entitled to and your votes will be counted.

Decrypting, Counting and Auditing

After close of polls, the telephone, web and poll place electronic votes are decrypted by election officials.

This results in the creation of sheets of totals, counts and audit data.

Swindon Voter Feedback

- **94.2% of e voters said the process was more convenient than going to a polling station**
- **91.8% of e voters said if e voting is available at future elections they would use it**
- **95.2% of internet voters and 98.3% of telephone voters found the process easy to use**
- **95.2% of e voters are confident that their vote was secure and would not be altered or misused**
